#### **Departmental Reports**

**Road Department Alex Turner** 

Mr. Turner stated that Truck 9 is back in service after the complete engine overhaul. As instructed by Jason Barlow from Navistar, he asked if Navistar would help cover some of the cost and he has not received a response.

Mitchell Road project of removing trees is complete and are completing the final design to help the water issue.

Also stated that gravel wash outs due to the weekend storms have been cleaned up and repaired.

Mr. Turner discussed the need for a Vac Truck for culvert clean outs. He stated he had looked at a unit that is on GOV Deals and it is well maintained. He requested permission to bid on the unit in an amount not to exceed \$43,000.00.

**Mr. Scoby** asked when water is vacuumed up are there restrictions on disposing of the water?

Mr. Turner replied as long as they are not vacuuming contaminated material there is no restriction on disposal.

Mr. Foley asked if the unit could blow out tiles.

Mr. Turner stated yes it has a high pressure water stream.

Mr. Roeder added that you can also with the high pressure dig a hole and vacuum the water and dirt up. This is safer if there are phone wires, electrical wires or gas pipes since it would decrease the risk of cutting them.

He also asked how often it would be utilized?

Mr. Turner responded that it would be used heavily in the spring and during construction season.

Mr. Foley asked Mr. Hively if funds were available.

Mr. Hively responded that during the planning meeting in November this was brought up by Mr. Turner. When the 2018 temporary appropriation budget was set and \$40,000.00 was input for this purpose. Also there is a resolution to make the appropriation budget permanent for 2018 and the \$40,000.00 is in this budget.
