BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Township Trustees to approve the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION EMPLOYING TOWNSHIP'S ATTORNEYS ON AN ANNUAL BASIS FOR THE YEAR 2024

WHEREAS, the Springfield Township Board of Trustees ("Board") is authorized by Section 309.09(B) of the Revised Code to employ attorneys on an annual basis other than the prosecuting attorney to represent the Township and its officers, boards, and commissions in their official capacities and to advise them on legal matters; and

WHEREAS, Section 309.09(B) of the Revised Code provides that no such attorney may be employed except on the order of the Board, duly entered upon its Journal, in which the compensation to be paid for the attorney's legal services shall be fixed; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds it necessary to appoint attorneys to counsel and represent the Township on an annual basis for the calendar year 2024 in such matters as the Board or its designee may refer to them; and

WHEREAS, the Board has appropriated the sum of \$5,000 for legal services for 2024;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Township Trustees of Springfield Township, Clark County, Ohio, that:

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SECTION 1. Peter N. Griggs of Brosius, Johnson & Griggs, LLC and the

The law firm of Brosius, Johnson & Griggs, LLC, are hereby employed on an Hannual basis for the calendar year 2024 as the Township's legal counsel to represent the Township and its officers, boards, and commissions in their official capacities and to advise them in connection with such matters as may be referred to said Counsel by or on behalf of the Board or its designee.

SECTION 2. The compensation for such counsel during 2024 shall be paid as follows: \$195.00 per hour attorney time; \$117.00 per hour law clerk time; and \$105.00 per hour legal assistant time; plus out-of-pocket expense reimbursements; provided that the total compensation shall not exceed \$5,000 without further action by this Board.

SECTION 3. The attorneys may be discharged at any time by the majority vote of the Board.

SECTION 4. The Township Fiscal Officer is directed to send a copy of this Resolution to the law firm.

SECTION 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including, without limitation, Section 121.22 of the Revised Code.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its adoption.

Ronnie Huson AT & T/FirstNet

I represent the state of Ohio from the south side central all the way to Cincinnati. I currently represent all the Sheriff's Offices, villages, townships, almost everything around Clark County.

I have had conversations with the township about switching to FirstNet.

This service started after 911. No one could talk to anyone. We now have a Ban14. FirstNet is owned by the government, and we now have a 25 year contract. With that contract we have to have 99.9 percent coverage. We have recently installed 491 towers in the state of Ohio in the last 5 years and have another 310 towers coming in the next 2 years.

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We have mobile vehicles to get signal when there is an emergency and towers are down. When there is a disaster we are sent out immediately. We will have a truck there within 18 hours.

FirstNet is the only public network that is owned by the government, as seen by the government as a safety network.

Kerry Schooler- Kerry's Cafe

I am here to request access to the bike path behind my property located at 2604 Springfield Xenia Rd, to allow entrance to our Coffee Shop for our shoppers.

Right now we are working on getting our coffee shop up and running. We do not know what we are going to do with the green houses.

Kerry Schooler We would like to replace the fence with a gate, and build a Bridgeway over the ditch line. We would have a path.
