Road Department

Billy Saunders Stated the crew is on their final round for leaves. Roger Storer Plumbing has begun the process of upgrading the touchless plumbing fixtures at the Road Department Building.

Fire/EMS

Jamie Allen Stated that Chief Nangle is recuperating from surgery and has started physical therapy. We have had up to 8 people affected by Covid contact tracing. We were contacted by Physio with regards to our Life Pack 15 (our cardiac monitors) and they are having a problem with the Asian supplier shipping the mother boards for this equipment, so if something would happen to those boards they will be unable to repair those units. So due to that issue they are offering to replace those units at a 50% discount, through December 31, 2020.

Our current units are 8 years old, so there is a Resolution if you would choose to replace those. We currently have 4, and cost is typically \$40,000 each. We do use 2 of them and the other 2 are back up units. So we are just asking for 2 replacements at approximately \$20,000.00 each.

Mr. Scoby I am receiving information about us having a few accidents involving Fire/EMS equipment. We have had 7 wrecks this year and I would like to have a report on each one and the cost. This is unusual to have this many accidents.

Jamie Allen We have addressed 2 of them. It was a backing up issue. Basically our policy is: you are supposed to have someone guiding you while backing up, if you have someone with you. The one involving the door, there had been a problem with that door and we didn't feel the door went all the way up. When D C Door came out the sensors were not working properly.
