To authorize the Ohio Department of Transportation to revise the prima-facie speed limit on E. Possum Road, Springfield Township, in accordance with Section 4511.21 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Whereas, the Board of Springfield Township Trustees have received requests by local citizens regarding the lowering of the existing speed limit of 55 mph on the subject road. Following procedures recommended by the Ohio Department of Transportation upon request by the Board, the County Engineer has documented: 1) the physical features of the roadway; 2) the existing control devised; 3) the results of the speed studies; 4) the traffic accidents that occurred over a three-year period;

Whereas, the County Engineer's Office has analyzed this data and the section of roads are more particularly described as follows:

E. Possum Road (TR234) between State Route 72 and Selma Pike (CR351), Springfield Township;

E. Possum Road (TR234/214) between Selma Pike (CR351) and E. Leffel Lane (TR224-), Springfield Township.

Whereas, it is the belief of this Board that the prima-facie speed limit on E. Possum Road is unrealistic and should be reduced to 45 mph for the section of the roadway between State Route 72 and Selma Pike, and should be reduced to 40 mph for the section of the roadway between Selma Pike and E. Leffel Lane based on the results of the speed zone studies.

Whereas, it is recommended that the Board pass a resolution requesting the Director of Transportation of the State of Ohio to review the attached documentation and to determine and declare a reasonable and safe prima-facie speed limit for these sections of the roadway.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Springfield Township Trustees, Clark County, Ohio, that the resolution requesting revision of the prima-facie speed limit on E. Possum Road, Springfield Township, in accordance with Section 4511.21 of the Ohio Revised Code, be and is hereby approved.
