We would like to sign a contract and get this started, it will be 29 to 30 months out before we would receive it. It is a state bid truck. We are having problems getting staff. We are asking for 6 new hires, but we are losing 4 employees. We would like to have conversation with the trustees about hiring a couple fulltime employees.

We will be needing some tools for next year. We need a staff vehicle.

Jim Scoby There was a fire in Holiday Hills and a number of residents spoke with me about not having a truck there.

Dave Nangle We were there. They had to come back from the hospital and get the truck. This is what we are talking about with staffing.

I have a couple quotes on some trucks that we will be looking at.

One is a new dump truck, so we can replace one of our older ones, and new trucks are 2 years out on production. A new mid-size truck for the new subdivisions, dead end roads, and the cemetery. We will need a new bed on one of the dump trucks we have now. (Exhibits for pricing)

John Roeder Keep in mind these trucks are taking 2 years in production. How many trucks will we be getting rid of, if we go with this plan? The smaller trucks work really well in all of our subdivisions.

Billy Saunders We would be getting rid of 2 trucks.

As of today we have spent \$227,000 on the Deputy Sheriff Contract, Dispatch fees for 2022, Bird Rd Project at \$15,000, and the Playground site at \$71,000. After our 2023 Deputy Sheriff fees, and dispatching fees for 2023, it will leave us a balance of approximately \$806,000. We do have a Health Insurance Resolution.

John Roeder We do have the Holiday and Capri Job which will be an additional job using ARPA Funds for 2023.

John Roeder We are working on getting a quit deed for the old fire house.

New Business

John Roeder In Garden Acres, there is a chain link fence going down Fernway that belongs to the Township. There is a resident that has cut our fence and wants to install a gate at the back of his property. There is a 10ft easement, and no vehicle access to that property from Fernway is allowed. We need send a letter to the resident stating our fence needs to be fixed and no gate allowed.

Tim Foley There may be a business coming into Prime Ohio II, and they are wanting to know if the trustees would permit an additional curb cut for a driveway off of Ridge Rd, rather than have a private drive off of Prime Ohio established roadway. I feel there is already enough curb cuts on Ridge Rd, that the access should be a private drive.

Jim Scoby The private drive is already set up and that is an expense we do not need.
